PACOG

Lewis would like to hire an intern to look through and organize files. A. Lewis explained that she plans to rebrand PACOG and reinvigorate it with what COGs need from a state association.

A **motion** was made by E. Hatchett and seconded by D. Thomas to hire an intern to sort through and organize PACOG files; billed to PACOG for salary expenses not covered by the LGA Municipal Intern Program. All in favor. Motion carried.

Regional Training Complex

T. Firda explained that recently Elizabeth Township began talking to Olympus Energy LLC about possible relocation of the Regional Training Complex to a large area of land they own. T. Firda also explained that SRCOG needs to be part of this conversation in the future.

Director's Report

HSC Updates

Brick Repointing

A. Lewis explained that we recently discovered that a water leak that is coming from brick that needs repointed.

A **motion** was made by D. Cress and seconded by J. Brown to authorize A. Lewis to hire Escajeda Masonry & Chimney to repoint a section of brick at the Human Services Center for a price not to exceed \$2,500.00. All in favor, Motion carried.

Lease Renewals

Have not yet sent out leases, working with F. Muscante to finalize. Since discussing leases, A. Lewis communicated with Devereux TCV Community Services, who still has two programs in the building, and has made the request for a month to month lease as she does not know what the future of funding looks like. Will revisit in Nov/Dec 2023 when state funding is more concrete.

A **motion** was made by E. Hatchett and seconded by T. Evans to authorize A. Lewis to continue a month-to-month lease with Devereux TCV Community Services at a rate of \$10/sq. ft. All in favor. Motion carried.

Street Sweeping

Rasul Abernathy has been hired and will begin training next week. A. Lewis explained that she's working on the schedule and all interested municipalities should reach out for scheduling.

Whole Home Repair Update

A. Lewis explained that SRCOG is continuing to receive interest forms and has received over 650 so far. A. Lewis noted that she would like to explore what capacity SRCOG would need to take on projects and services like this in the future. The Board agreed this would be a good idea; A. Lewis and staff to continue research.

DHS Violence Prevention Program Update

WPXI covered the Cure Violence program that is being deployed in Clairton, Duquesne, Homestead, and McKeesport. The report is a helpful insight into how the program will work. A. Lewis explained that a Program Manager and two Supervisors have been hired and the team is currently interviewing for the remaining positions.

Personnel Updates

A. Lewis explained that the DHS program is still searching for a Program Coordinator to lead shooting reviews, speak to social service and nonprofit organizations, coordinate with the police, and has an interest in violence prevention.

A. Lewis explained that SRCOG is also looking to hire a Community Engagement Coordinator that will help to be a presence for SRCOG at municipal events, meetings, etc. Looking for people in SRCOG communities with great social skills.
